Lesson 1

[1. Who is God? \(Click\)](#)

Click Slide 1:

God is eternal and was here long before humanity- Turn there together and read

Psalm 90:2 Authorized (King James) Version (AKJV)

2 Before the mountains were brought forth,
or ever thou hadst formed the earth and the world,
even from everlasting to everlasting, thou *art* God.

Everlasting-5769- (forever)

Forever- without ever ending, eternally

Eternally- without beginning or end, lasting forever, always existing (opposed to temporal)

Temporal- of or relating to time

“from without ever ending, thou art God”

Other scriptures to study: (Rev 1:8) (Job 36:26)(Job 38:4-6)(Isaiah 57:15)

In attempting to understand who God is, it is important to establish who God is not. He is not a God who takes pleasure in wickedness nor shall any evil live with him

Click Slide 2:

God is Holy and perfect (Turn there and read together)

Psalm 5:4-6 Authorized (King James) Version (AKJV)

4 For thou *art* not a God that hath pleasure in wickedness:
neither shall evil dwell with thee.

5 The foolish (arrogant) shall not stand in thy sight:
thou hatest all workers of iniquity (evil doers).

6 Thou shalt destroy them that speak leasing (tell lies) :
the Lord will abhor the bloody and deceitful man.

Abhor-8581 “to loathe, detest”

Loathe- feel intense dislike for

(Psalm 18:30)

God is love and He is a Spirit (Click slide 3) (John 4:24)(1st John 4:8)

2. Creation and humanities purpose

Click Slide 4: - click slides for each creation day and teach from the slides

Genesis 1

Humanity's purpose, why were we created?

#1. To rule and have dominion in the earth

Genesis 1:26-28 (Turn to scripture and read aloud, ask them read if they are able to.)

And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth. **27** So God created man in his *own* image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them. **28** And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth.

Click Slide 5: (Click the five points in the slides and explain each one)

#2. We were created for Gods glory (through our lives put on display who he is. To bring him glory and honor)- **Isaiah 43:7**

#3. We were created to serve the Lord with gladness because he is good.-
Psalm 100

#4. We were created to worship, bow, and kneel before the Lord our maker because he is a great God and the king above all gods. Psalm 95:3-6

#5 We were created to worship no other god but the Lord Exodus 34:14

3. God's commandment to man in the garden of Eden

Click slide 6

Genesis 2:15 Authorized (King James) Version (AKJV) (Also on screen)

15 And the Lord God took the man, and put him into the garden of Eden to dress it and to keep it. 16 And the Lord God commanded the man, saying, Of every tree of the garden thou mayest freely eat: 17 but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.

Click slide 7

4. Introduction to the accuser of our soul, satan

Click slide 8

Satan is also known as the serpent, the deceiver, & the tempter, he is a fallen angel: Who was in heaven once and was kicked out into the earth because of his rebellion.

(Turn to scripture and read aloud) **Ezekiel 28:13-17**

Authorized (King James) Version (AKJV)

13 Thou hast been in Eden the garden of God;
every precious stone *was* thy covering,
the sardius, topaz, and the diamond,
the beryl, the onyx, and the jasper,
the sapphire, the emerald, and the carbuncle, and gold:
the workmanship of thy tabrets and of thy pipes
was prepared in thee in the day that thou wast created.

Workmanship- 4399 “deputy-ship, ministry, employment, work”
Deputy-ship- a person appointed or empowered to work for another

Tabrets-8596- “a tambourine”

Pipes-5345 - “a bezel for a gem, a pipe”

Bezel- a grooved ring holding the glass or plastic cover of a watch face or other instrument in position.

Prepared-3559- “to be erect ,to set up ,establish, fix, prepare, apply”

14 Thou *art* the anointed cherub that covereth; and I have set thee so: thou wast upon the holy mountain of God; thou hast walked up and down in the midst of the stones of fire.

15 Thou *wast* perfect in thy ways from the day that thou wast created, till iniquity was found in thee.

16 By the multitude of thy merchandise they have filled the midst of thee with violence, and thou hast sinned: therefore I will cast thee as profane out of the mountain of God: and I will destroy thee, O covering cherub, from the midst of the stones of fire.

17 Thine heart was lifted up because of thy beauty, thou hast corrupted thy wisdom by reason of thy brightness: I will cast thee to the ground, I will lay thee before kings, that they may behold thee.

Point #1 Satan has the ability to transform himself to appear as light:

2 Corinthians 11:14-15 Authorized (King James) Version (AKJV)

¹⁴And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light. ¹⁵Therefore *it is* no great thing if his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness; whose end shall be according to their works.

Transformed 3345 “to transfigure, to disguise”

Point #2 He and his angels were kicked out of heaven and has gone about to deceive the whole world :

2 Peter 2:4 Authorized (King James) Version (AKJV)

⁴For if God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast *them* down to hell, and delivered *them* into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment;

Revelation 12:9 Authorized (King James) Version (AKJV)

⁹And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.

Revelation 12:12 Authorized (King James) Version (AKJV)

¹²Therefore rejoice, ye heavens, and ye that dwell in them. Woe to the inhabitants of the earth and of the sea! for the devil is come down unto you, having great wrath, because he knoweth that he hath but a short time.

Point #3 Satan is a liar and the source of all lies:

John 8:44 Authorized (King James) Version (AKJV)

⁴⁴Ye are of *your* father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.

Proverbs 14:12 Authorized (King James) Version (AKJV)

¹²There is a way which seemeth right unto a man,
but the end thereof *are* the ways of death.

Hebrews 4:12 Authorized (King James) Version (AKJV)

¹²For the word of God *is* quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and *is* a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

Discerner-2924 “decisive” “critical” discriminative”

Decisive- settling an issue; producing a definite result.

Point #4 Satan’s destiny is the lake of fire & to burn forever and ever

(Revelation 20:10 on screen)

5. The fall of the human race: Humanity separated from God for eternity:

Satan first appeared to humanity in the garden of Eden where he lied to Eve. Satan then deceived Eve, who then passed the deception on to Adam. Humanity then fell into sin and offended the Holy God by disobeying him.

(Turn there and read) **Genesis 3** Authorized (King James) Version (AKJV)

3 Now the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field which the Lord God had made. And he said unto the woman, Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden? **2** And the woman said unto the serpent, We may eat of the fruit of the trees of the garden: **3** but of the fruit of the tree which *is* in the midst of the garden, God hath said, Ye shall not eat of it, neither shall ye touch it, lest ye die. **4** And the serpent said unto the woman, Ye shall not surely die: **5** for God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil. **6** And when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make *one* wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat. **7** And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they *were* naked; and they sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves aprons.

8 And they heard the voice of the Lord God walking in the garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the Lord God amongst the trees of the garden. **9** And the Lord God called unto Adam, and said unto him, Where *art* thou? **10** And he said, I heard thy voice in the garden, and I was afraid, because I *was* naked; and I hid myself. **11** And he said, Who told thee that thou *wast* naked? Hast thou eaten of the tree, whereof I commanded thee that thou shouldest not eat? **12** And the man said, The woman whom thou gavest *to be* with me, she gave me of the tree, and I did eat. **13** And the Lord God said unto the woman, What *is* this *that* thou hast done? And the woman said, The serpent beguiled me, and I did eat. **14** And the Lord God said unto the serpent, Because thou hast done this, thou *art* cursed above all cattle, and above every beast of the field; upon thy belly shalt thou go, and dust shalt thou eat all the days of thy life: **15** and I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel. **16** Unto the woman he said, I will greatly multiply thy sorrow and thy conception; in sorrow thou shalt bring forth children; and thy desire *shall be* to thy husband, and he shall rule over thee. **17** And unto Adam he said, Because thou hast hearkened unto the voice of thy wife, and hast eaten of the tree, of which I commanded thee, saying, Thou shalt not eat of it: cursed *is* the ground for thy sake; in sorrow shalt thou eat *of* it all the days of thy life; **18** thorns also and thistles shall it bring forth to thee; and thou shalt eat the herb of the field; **19** in the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread, till thou return unto the ground; for out of it wast thou taken: for dust thou *art*, and unto dust shalt thou return. **20** And Adam called his wife's name Eve; because she was the

mother of all living. **21** Unto Adam also and to his wife did the Lord God make coats of skins, and clothed them.

22 And the Lord God said, Behold, the man is become as one of us, to know good and evil: and now, lest he put forth his hand, and take also of the tree of life, and eat, and live for ever: **23** therefore the Lord God sent him forth from the garden of Eden, to till the ground from whence he was taken. **24** So he drove out the man; and he placed at the east of the garden of Eden Cherubims, and a flaming sword which turned every way, to keep the way of the tree of life.

Click Slide 9: (Sin separated us from God) and continues to separate us from God)

As we remember, God is holy and eternal, therefore he deals in eternal terms, so Adams death was not only his first physical death, but also a second eternal death. An eternal spiritual death worthy of the lake of fire to burn forever and ever because of sin against a holy God.

When Adam and Eve sinned they became spiritually dead because they were apart from God who is life. Their sentence for their sin was eternal death.

Click Slide 10:

Adam's sin and death passed down to all humanity, even us.

Romans 5:12 Authorized (King James) Version (AKJV)

12 Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:

(Without Jesus we are currently living under an eternal death sentence because we inherited Adams sin)

Click Slide 11:

Because we inherited Adam's sin nature, our future for our offence against a holy God was to burn in the lake of fire for all eternity. This is called the second death, we all will eventually die off from this earth, that is the first death. But the second death is for humanity to burn forever in eternal punishment for our sins.

Sin is in us as sure as the color of our skin, or the spots of a leopard

Jeremiah 13:23 Authorized (King James) Version (AKJV)

23 Can the Ethiopian change his skin, or the leopard his spots?
then may ye also do good, that are accustomed to do evil.

Revelation 20:11-15 Authorized (King James) Version (AKJV) (Turn there and read together)

11 And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them. **12** And I saw **the dead**, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is *the book of life* (Ex 32:33): and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.

James 2:10-11 Authorized (King James) Version (AKJV)

¹⁰ For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one *point*, he is guilty of all. ¹¹ For he that said, Do not commit adultery, said also, Do not kill. Now if thou commit no adultery, yet if thou kill, thou art become a transgressor of the law.

13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works. **14** And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. **This is the second death.** **15** And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.

Click Slide 12

End of lesson 1:

(Discuss this lesson; if they are hungry proceed with more).

6. God's plan to redeem humanity from sin and death

The problem is sin and death, these were now the new champions over humanity the moment Adam and Eve sinned in the garden. Sin and death were beginning to claim the lives of all humanity not only here on earth, but the lives of all for all eternity.

Click Slide: 13

Click slide: Sin and death were champion over all humans who would be born since Adams fall, satan had the keys to death and hell over humanity

Click slide: Romans 5:14

¹"Nevertheless death reigned"

Click slide: Romans 5:21

"that as sin hath reigned unto death...."

Because every person was born into sin, every person was destined to die an eternal death (Psalm 51:5)(Isaiah 5:14) "Hell hath enlarged herself and openeth her mouth without measure"

Click Slide 14:

Click slide 15: Sin produces death of all kinds:

Click: We see the first case of jealousy because of sin. We see the first murder because of sin. All between two brothers. Cain kills his brother Abel (Genesis 4:1-8)

Click Slide 16

It doesn't stop: Just two chapters later the sin and wickedness of humanity has become so wicked God destroys humanity in a flood. After Noah preached righteousness and the whole world ignored him. God spared Noah and starts over with Noah and his family. (Genesis 6:5-8)

Click Slide 17

Click: God was angry at the sins that separated us from him, our sins came between us and God.

Click: Isaiah 59:2

Click Slide 18 (God hates sin because it separated us from him for an eternity)

Click Slide 19 God's punishment to the serpent/satan/the deceiver in the garden of Eden.

Genesis 3:15

"And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel."

Click: The woman and seed that God was talking about was The virgin Mary and Jesus Christ! God spoke this thousands of years before Jesus came.

Click Slide 20 That Messiah comes to earth! JESUS!

Matthew 1:18-21 (Turn to scripture and read together)

18 Now the birth of Jesus Christ was on this wise: When as his mother Mary was espoused to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Ghost. **19** Then Joseph her husband, being a just *man*, and not willing to make her a publick example, was minded to put her away privily. **20** But while he thought on these things, behold, the angel of the Lord appeared unto him in a dream, saying, Joseph, thou son of David, fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost. **21** And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins.

Click Slide 21 The life of Jesus while on earth (Teach from slides with each click)

Click Slide 22- The humanity of Jesus (Teach from each slide with one click)

Click Slide 23 Jesus laid down his life freely for us (Read scriptures on the screen)

Yet he still gave up his own will for us!

Click Slide 24 The cup of Gods wrath towards our sins:

Click: Luke 22:42

Click Slide 25

Click: The curse of every sin was upon Jesus

The sins of all of those from the Old Testament that believed in God as well as those who had not yet been created Jesus was going to take upon all of those sins in his body! (Hebrews 9:15)

Click: 1 Peter 2:24 Authorized (King James) Version (AKJV)

24 who his own self bare (carried) our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.

Jesus was beaten to a pulp, because our sins were on him

Isaiah 53:4-6 Authorized (Turn there together and read)

4 Surely he hath borne our griefs,
and carried our sorrows:
yet we did esteem him stricken,
smitten of God, and afflicted.

5 But he was wounded for our transgressions,
he was bruised for our iniquities:
the chastisement of our peace was upon him;
and with his stripes we are healed.

6 All we like sheep have gone astray;
we have turned every one to his own way;
and the Lord hath laid on him the iniquity of us all.

7

He was oppressed, and he was afflicted,
yet he opened not his mouth:
he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter,
and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb,
so he openeth not his mouth.

God hid this from the world so that they could crucify Jesus, because by crucifying Jesus our sins were being judged!

1 Corinthians 2:8 Authorized (King James) Version (AKJV)

8 which none of the princes of this world knew: for had they known *it*, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory.

Before dying, Jesus hung on the cross for 6 hours. While he was hanging there he was taking on all of humanities sins in his body on the cross all past sins, present sins, and future sins. As the roman soldiers were beating him and stabbing him, it was God taking out his punishment on our sins! God was taking out his wrath on all our sins all in the body of Jesus so that his wrath could be satisfied.

Click Slide 26: It is finished: This means that God had finished punishing our sins which were upon Jesus' body. (John 19:30)

Click: Romans 8:3 "God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, **condemned sin in the flesh:**"

Jesus died on the cross, then they buried him. Because all of those sins that he took on himself required a death (Romans 6:23), so Jesus died and went to where sin brings us, the death/hell.

Click: Hebrews 2:9 he by the grace of God should taste death for every man.

Romans 5:17

17 For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ.)

Click Slide 27- Jesus suffered death and went to hell

While Jesus was dead and in hell apart from live amongst the dead. he buried our sins that were in his body in the deepest part of the sea (Micah 7:19)- **Click Slide 28**

While Jesus was dead and in hell apart from life he was quickened and made alive by the Spirit of God and preached to the evil spirits that imprisoned all of humanity and took the keys of death and hell from satan. **Click Slide 29**

1 Peter 3:18-20 King James Version (KJV)

18 For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the Spirit:

19 By which also he went and preached unto the spirits in prison;

By the Spirit of Almighty God that was in Jesus, he rose up and proclaimed to the devil, death, and hell, that he was Almighty God and he broke the chains of death and hell.

Click: read scripture on screen (**Hebrews 2:14-15**)

Jesus rose on the third day as he said he would with all victory

Click: Revelation 1:18

18 I am he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen;

and have the keys of hell and of death

(Matthew 28:1-10)

Click Slide 30: Jesus came back to life on earth with all power in heaven and in earth. He has the power of death and the power over eternal life.

John 6:65 King James Version (KJV)

⁶⁵ And he said, Therefore said I unto you, that no man can come unto me, except it were given unto him of my Father.

This gospel is the power of God!

Romans 1:16 Authorized (King James) Version (AKJV)

16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.

The Father by his grace has led you to this place

John 6:65 Authorized (King James) Version (AKJV)

65 And he said, Therefore said I unto you, that no man can come unto me, except it were given unto him of my Father.

How do we receive this salvation?

Food stamp analogy: People who receive food stamps don't just get them

because they say that they want them, they must obey the instructions given to them by the food stamp office in order to receive them. Like wise it is the same way with the salvation of our souls, we must obey the instructions given to us by God himself in order to receive this salvation.

Someone covering our airfare and hotel arrangement analogy

Click Slide 31: Jesus then commanded his disciples to go and spread this message to every human being! (Read all three scriptures on screen) –**This is my part and my responsibility as a disciple of the Lord Jesus Christ.**

Click Slide 32 Jesus commanded us to quit and turn from our sins, the very same sins that he suffered for and the sins that separates us from the Father. The sins that God hates, he commanded us to turn from them. – **Your part & your responsibility is to follow the Lords instructions and to repent. Are you ready to repent? If so read Luke 14:25-35.**

After reading this ask them if they are still willing to repent

(if they are not willing to repent, then stop this part and take them to the eternal condemnation part)

Click Slide 33

Click 1: We can either die in our sins, (the same sins that Jesus already paid for in his death for us) and go to a burning lake of fire for ever and ever

or

Click 2: we can repent, feel sorry for the sins that broke Gods heart and the sins that separate us from him and turn from them and turn to Jesus to have life more abundantly and everlasting life.

This is the good news, that we are no longer under an eternal death sentence and

that our sins are paid for if we turn to Jesus Christ!

Ezekiel 33:11 King James Version (KJV)

11 Say unto them, As I live, saith the Lord God, I have no pleasure in the death of the wicked; but that the wicked turn from his way and live: turn ye, turn ye from your evil ways; for why will ye die, O house of Israel?

True repentance will produce self denial, which is what Jesus requires to follow him.
Matthew 10:32-39 Authorized (King James) Version (AKJV)

32 Whosoever therefore shall confess me before men, him will I confess also before my Father which is in heaven. **33** But whosoever shall deny me before men, him will I also deny before my Father which is in heaven.

34 Think not that I am come to send peace on earth: I came not to send peace, but a sword. **35** For I am come to set a man at variance against his father, and the daughter against her mother, and the daughter in law against her mother in law.

36 And a man's foes *shall be* they of his own household. **37** He that loveth father or mother more than me is not worthy of me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me. **38** And he that taketh not his cross, and followeth after me, is not worthy of me. **39** He that findeth his life shall lose it: and he that loseth his life for my sake shall find it.

2 Corinthians 5:15 Authorized (King James) Version (AKJV) **15** and *that* he died for all, that they which live should not henceforth live unto themselves, but unto him which died for them, and rose again.

Ask them what is their decision?

1. Do you think differently now after hearing the gospel of Jesus?
2. Will you reconsider the direction of your life? How do you feel about your sins?
3. Do you still like it, or now after hearing about what sin is and what sin does and

the result of sin are you ready to change and hate your sin because of what it did to separate you from your creator and Father?

4. Are you ready to give your life to Jesus?

If so

Mark 16:16

16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.

If not: (Eternal Condemnation)

If they reject, a reminder and fair warning:

Hebrews 10:26-31 New Living Translation (NLT)

26 Dear friends, if we deliberately continue sinning after we have received knowledge of the truth, there is no longer any sacrifice that will cover these sins.

27 There is only the terrible expectation of God's judgment and the raging fire that will consume his enemies. **28** For anyone who refused to obey the law of Moses was put to death without mercy on the testimony of two or three witnesses. **29** Just think how much worse the punishment will be for those who have trampled on the Son of God, and have treated the blood of the covenant, which made us holy, as if it were common and unholy, and have insulted and disdained the Holy Spirit who brings God's mercy to us. **30** For we know the one who said,

"I will take revenge.

I will pay them back."^[a]

He also said,

"The Lord will judge his own people."^[b]

31 It is a terrible thing to fall into the hands of the living God.

2 Thessalonians 1:7-9 Authorized (King James) Version (AKJV)

7 and to you who are troubled rest with us, **when the Lord Jesus shall be revealed from heaven with his mighty angels, 8 in flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God, and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ: 9 who shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of his power;**

Then depart.
